1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11109-A, sub-§2, ¶A, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 492, §1, is
3	repealed.
4	SUMMARY
5	Current law allows a super pack license holder to receive an antlerless deer permit
6	and to have an opportunity to enter an antlerless deer permit lottery pursuant to the Maine
7	Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 11152. This bill removes the provision that gives a
8	person holding a super pack license the opportunity to enter an antlerless deer permit
9	lottery thus limiting the number of antlerless deer permits a person holding a super pack
10	license may have to one.
