COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 689, L.D. 934, “Resolve, To Review the Implementation of the Maine Background Check Center Act”

Amend the resolve in section 1 by striking out all of subsections 3 and 4 and inserting the following:

- '3. Ways to allow for the portability of a background check so that it can travel with an employee from one job to another within a 5-year time frame;
- 4. The necessity of subjecting to the background check system current employees who had been subject to a background check within the previous 5 years; and
- 5. Any barriers to implementing all required background checks under one background check system.'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the unanimous report of the committee, adds a directive to the study group to consider any barriers to implementing all required background checks under one background check system.
