Notwithstanding Title 1, chapter 13, subchapter 4 1, an e-mail address recorded on a license application is confidential except for the use of department personnel or law enforcement personnel or for the purposes of court 5 proceedings. 6 7 **SUMMARY** 8 This bill provides, with certain exceptions, that e-mail addresses provided on license 9 applications to the Department of Marine Resources are confidential.
