COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 733, L.D. 1050, Bill, “An Act To Protect the Safety of Emergency Medical Services Personnel and Patients”

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 2. 25 MRSA §2011, sub-§3-A** is enacted to read:

**3-A. Exception for emergency medical services vehicle.** This section does not prohibit an order, ordinance, rule or regulation of any political subdivision requiring that a firearm carried inside an emergency medical services vehicle that is owned or operated by or on behalf of the political subdivision be locked in a lockbox by emergency medical services personnel.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment is one of 2 minority reports from the committee. The amendment does not prohibit a political subdivision of the State from adopting an order, ordinance, rule or regulation requiring that a firearm carried inside an emergency medical services vehicle that is owned or operated by or on behalf of the political subdivision be locked in a lockbox by emergency medical services personnel.
