Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services to designate ombudsman. Resolved: That the Department of Health and Human Services shall designate an intensive case manager working in the county jails to serve as a health care ombudsman to oversee county jail inmates with medical and mental health care needs and connect them to the health care services for which they qualify. The health care ombudsman also shall assist county jail inmates in receiving the medications they need in a timely fashion.

SUMMARY

This resolve directs the Department of Health and Human Services to designate an intensive case manager working in the county jails to serve as a health care ombudsman to oversee county jail inmates with medical and mental health care needs and connect them to the health care services for which they qualify. The health care ombudsman also assists county jail inmates in receiving the medications they need in a timely fashion.
