.4 .5 .6	7-B. Hunting deer over bait. A hunting license of a person convicted of placing or hunting over bait in violation of section 11452, subsection 1 must be revoked, and that person is ineligible to obtain a hunting license as follows:
.7	A. For a first offense, for a period of one year from the date of conviction; and
.8	B. For a 2nd offense, for a period of 2 years from the date of conviction.'
.9	SUMMARY
20 21 22 23	This amendment provides, like the bill, that the hunting license of a person who is convicted of hunting over bait during an open season on deer must be revoked for one year. The amendment adds a provision for a 2-year revocation for a 2nd offense. The amendment removes the provision of the bill that imposes a mandatory fine of \$500.
