13 This amendment is the majority report of the committee. This amendment removes section 2 of the bill, which changes the process for the appointment of the Director of the 14 Efficiency Maine Trust. This amendment also removes section 4 of the bill, which 15 clarifies that the procurement cap is to apply to the total retail electricity supply and 16 transmission and distribution sales in the State. Lastly, it specifies that Efficiency Maine 17 Trust funds provided to fund the Maine Energy Office may only be used for office 18 activities that support or are reasonably related to programs or activities of the Efficiency 19 20 Maine Trust.
