3 4	<u>§902-B.</u> Signatures on petitions for direct initiative of legislation from congressional <u>districts</u>
5 6 7 8 9	The required number of signatures on petitions for the direct initiative of legislation specified in the Constitution of Maine, Article IV, Part Third, Section 18 must include a number of signatures of voters registered to vote in each congressional district that is equal to 10% of the total vote for Governor cast in that congressional district in the last gubernatorial election preceding the filing of the direct initiative.
