1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §6030-H is enacted to read:
3	§6030-H. Limit on initial amount paid by tenant or prospective tenant
4 5 6	At or prior to the commencement of a tenancy, a landlord, the landlord's agent or a real estate broker may not require a tenant or prospective tenant to pay an amount in excess of the following:
7	1. Rent. The rent for the first full month of occupancy;
8	2. Security deposit. A security deposit as limited by section 6032; and
9	3. Key and lock. The purchase and installation cost for a key and lock.

11 12 13 14	This bill provides that at or prior to the commencement of a tenancy, a landlord, the landlord's agent or a real estate broker may not require a tenant or prospective tenant to pay an amount in excess of the rent for the first full month of occupancy, a security deposit and the purchase and installation cost for a key and lock.
