Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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- establish various grant and loan instruments as part of the Maine Agriculture, Food and Forest Products Investment Fund. It appropriates \$20,000,000 per fiscal year to the fund. It directs the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to establish 2 positions within the department.
