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The amendment adds the requirement that the Maine State Housing Authority submit
preliminary reports by February 1, 2017 on the authority's progress in increasing access to
affordable housing pursuant to section 2 of the bill and on the extent to which the rental
assistance pilot program created in section 3 of the bill achieves success in meeting its
goals.
