COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1115, L.D. 1638, Bill, “An Act To Increase Payments to MaineCare Providers That Are Subject to Maine's Service Provider Tax”

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting the following:

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the State's MaineCare providers that are subject to the service provider tax have experienced an increase in the tax since January 1, 2016; and

Whereas, MaineCare providers have insufficient reserves to withstand cost increases; and

Whereas, private nonmedical institutions and other facilities provide services to Maine's vulnerable citizens, including children, individuals with substance use disorders, and adults with intellectual disabilities and autistic disorder; and

Whereas, private nonmedical institutions and other facilities that provide such services need increased funding to continue providing those services; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

 18 legislation takes effect when approved.'

19 **SUMMARY**

20 This amendment strikes the bill and instead provides an appropriations and
 21 allocations section that adds funding for an increase in reimbursement rates to eligible
 22 MaineCare providers for the last 3 months of fiscal year 2015-16 and for fiscal year
 23 2016-17. The purpose of the additional funding is to offset the imposition of the service
 24 provider tax, which took effect January 1, 2016. This amendment also adds an
 25 emergency preamble and emergency clause.
