1	SUMMARY
2	This amendment is the minority report of the committee. It removes language from
3	the bill that removes the requirement that the Governor keep the Governor's office at the
4	State House. It also removes the section that increases the salaries of members of the
5	Senate and House of Representatives by 25% if the number of members of the Senate is
6	reduced to 25 or fewer and the number of members of the House of Representatives is
7	reduced to 100 or fewer. It retains the section that increases the Governor's salary from
8	\$70,000 per year to \$150,000 per year beginning January 2019.
