COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1320, L.D. 2058, “An Act Regarding Compliance with Environmental Permit and License Application Requirements”

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 11th line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "previously" and inserting the following: ', within the 5 years immediately preceding the submission of the application,'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the nonacceptance of a permit or license application submitted to the Department of Environmental Protection after the activity requiring the permit or license has begun may be based on the applicant knowingly violating a requirement to obtain a permit or license for the activity or the applicant violating, within the 5 years immediately preceding the submission of the application, a requirement to obtain a permit or license.
