The Commissioner of Conservation shall submit suggested legislation that codifies the duties and responsibilities of these transferred positions in Title 12, Part 8 to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters no later than December 17, 2012. The joint standing committee may submit a bill regarding that submission to the First Regular Session of the 126th Legislature.'
