SUMMARY

9 This amendment, which is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on 10 Labor, Commerce, Research and Economic Development, extends the bill's requirement for the payment of the prevailing hourly rate of wages and benefits for all public works 11 contracts to include public works funded by a municipality or school district when the 12 State has transferred any amount of funding to the municipality or school district for 13 14 those purposes. The amendment also changes the bill by retaining the exemption in 15 current law for contracts under \$50,000. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section. 16
