1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1774, sub-§§1 and 2**, as enacted by PL 2009, c. 516, §1, are
3 amended to read:

4 **1. Motor vehicles and watercraft.** Motor vehicles as defined in Title 29-A, section
5 101, subsection 42 and watercraft as defined in Title 12, section 13001, subsection 28 or
6 their component parts; ~~and~~

7 **2. Pulp and paper manufacturers.** Pulp and paper manufacturers except
8 conversion facilities for consumer product packaging; and

9 **Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §1774, sub-§3** is enacted to read:

10 **3. Specialized equipment.** Specialized manufacturing equipment and specialized
11 processing equipment, including any component of such equipment, used in the
12 production and repair of industrial or commercial goods and not generally discarded as
13 solid waste.

14 **SUMMARY**

15 This bill exempts specialized manufacturing equipment, specialized processing
16 equipment and their components from the laws governing product stewardship.
