5	requires alternative compliance payments made by competitive electricity providers to the
6	Public Utilities Commission to be used by the commission to provide needs-based low-
7	income assistance in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 3214,
8	subsection 2. The amendment also repeals the law establishing the Energy Efficiency and
9	Renewable Resource Fund.
