An Act To Prohibit Smoking in Bus Shelters

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1542, sub-§1,** as amended by PL 2009, c. 140, §1, is further amended to read:
- **1. Prohibition.** Smoking is prohibited in all enclosed areas of public places, <u>including bus shelters</u>, <u>in</u> outdoor eating areas as provided in section 1550 and <u>in</u> all rest rooms made available to the public. In the case of a child care facility that is not home-based, smoking is also prohibited in a facility-designated motor vehicle within 12 hours before transporting a child who is in the care of the child care facility, and whenever such a child is present in the vehicle. Smoking is also prohibited in outdoor areas of the facility where children may be present.
