This amendment does the following:

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- 1. It makes changes to the definition of "temporary nurse agency," including that home health care services providers are not included in the definition;
- 2. It repeals the exception to the registration requirement for home health care services providers and temporary nurses not affiliated with an agency;
- 3. It allows the Department of Health and Human Services to impose a fine for failure of a temporary nurse agency to provide required documentation or to submit annual reports; and

1	4. It makes violation of the requirements relating to temporary nurse agencies a
2	violation of the Maine Unfair Trade Practices Act.
