2	Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §1065 is enacted to read:
3	§1065. Distances
4 5 6	For the purposes of this chapter, unless otherwise provided in the laws relating to the Gambling Control Board, distances are determined by measuring along the most commonly used roadway, as determined by the Department of Transportation.

8 9	This bill makes a technical clarification regarding the determination of distance in the laws governing the Department of Public Safety, Gambling Control Board.
