Sec. 2. Reporting date established. Resolved: That, no later than January 15,
2016, the Commissioner of Financial and Professional Regulation shall submit a report
with any necessary legislation following the independent assessment under section 1 to
the Joint Standing Committee on Labor, Commerce, Research and Economic
Development and the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. Both committees are
authorized to submit a bill on the subject matter of the report to the Second Regular
Session of the 127th Legislature.
