I	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §3211, sub-§7 is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	7. Funding. The Maine Apprenticeship Program shall apply at least 75% of program funding toward apprenticeship programs in which the apprentice earns at least 1.5 times the rate of the minimum wage, pursuant to section 664, upon completion of the apprenticeship agreement.
