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SENATE AMENDMENT

SUMMARY

2 This amendment requires the Department of Conservation and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to take a proactive approach to pursuing land conservation 3 projects that include significant wildlife habitat conservation, including conservation of 4 5 priority deer wintering areas. It includes a description of priority deer wintering areas and provisions regarding the management of areas that contain wildlife or fish habitat. It 6 includes a reference to Public Law 2005, chapter 462, Part B, section 6 regarding the 7 process and selection criteria for the acquisition of working waterfront properties. It 8 clarifies that the proceeds of the bonds for the Land for Maine's Future Board may be 9 expended by the Department of Conservation for the acquisition of wildlife or fish 10 11 habitat.
