- **Sec. 4. Contingent effective date.** That section of this Act that repeals and replaces the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 3174-CCC, subsection 1 does not take effect unless:
- 1. The United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services approves a state plan amendment to allow for Medicaid reimbursement for physical therapy services performed by chiropractic doctors licensed under Title 32, chapter 9 within their scope of practice as long as those services are covered when performed by licensed physical therapists; and
- 2. The Commissioner of Health and Human Services notifies the Secretary of State, the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Revisor of Statutes that written approval for the state plan amendment has been received.'

33 SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement in the bill to provide MaineCare reimbursement for all services within a chiropractic doctor's scope of practice and replaces it with reimbursement for physical therapy services within a chiropractic doctor's scope of practice that are otherwise covered if provided by a licensed physical therapist. It includes in chiropractic services that are reimbursable under MaineCare the manual manipulation of the spine, which is already covered under Department of Health and Human Services
