15	this paragraph in developing a plan to participate in the federal summer food service
16	program for children and in obtaining federal, state and private funds to pay for this
17	program. Beginning with the 2011-2012 school year, a school administrative unit
18	with at least one public school in which the percentage of students who qualify for a
19	free or reduced-price lunch is determined to be equal to or greater than the minimum
20	percentage established for eligibility under the National School Lunch Program
21	described in paragraph A may participate in the federal summer food service program
22	for children in accordance with 42 United States Code, Section 1761, subject to the
23	following phase-in schedule:
24	(1) For the summer following the 2011-2012 school year, a school
25	administrative unit with at least one public school in which at least 75% of
26	students qualified for a free or reduced-price lunch in the 2011-2012 school year
27	may participate in the federal summer food service program;
28	(2) For the summer following the 2012-2013 school year, a school
29	administrative unit with at least one public school in which at least 65% of
30	students qualified for a free or reduced-price lunch in the 2012-2013 school year
31	may participate in the federal summer food service program; and
32	(3) For the summer following the 2013-2014 school year and each subsequent
33	school year, a school administrative unit with at least one public school in which
34	at least 50% of students qualified for a free or reduced-price lunch in that school
35	year may participate in the federal summer food service program.'
36	Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 6 and 7.

l	SUMMARY
2	This amendment clarifies that school administrative units do not have to participate in
3	the federal summer food service program for children but may participate and receive
4	support services from the Department of Education.
