1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §111, sub-§5, as amended by PL 2005, c. 387, §1, is repealed.
4	Sec. 2. 21-A MRSA §340, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 423, §3, is repealed.
5	Sec. 3. 21-A MRSA §341 is enacted to read:
6	§341. Unenrolled voter participation in primary elections allowed
7	A registered voter not enrolled in a political party may participate, subject to the
8	restrictions of section 144, in a party's primary election without enrolling in that political
9	party. An unenrolled voter may vote in only one party's primary election. Municipal
10	clerks shall establish procedures to ensure that each voter voting in a party's primary
11	election is offered a ballot for that primary election.
12	SUMMARY
13	This bill allows unenrolled voters to vote in primary elections without having to
14	enroll in a political party.
