| 4 5 6 | 2. Charitable dentist license. "Charitable dentist license" means the authority granted to an individual to provide free dental care as requested by a charitable or social organization within the State when resident dental services are not available. |

| 9 10 | 3. Fees. The authority to adopt by rule fees for purposes authorized under this chapter in amounts that are reasonable and necessary for their respective purposes, except that: |
| 11 12 | A. The fee for any one purpose may not exceed \$550 unless another fee is authorized by paragraph B Θr_{x} C or D; |
| 13 14 | B. The fee for an initial license or a license renewal under section 18342 or a permit under section 18379 may not exceed \$1,000; and |
| 15 16 | C. The fee for an initial license or a license renewal under section 18345 may not exceed \$200; and |
| 17 18 | D. The fee for an initial license or a license renewal under section 18342, subsection 5 is \$0. |

| 21 22 | 5. Charitable dentist license. An applicant for a charitable dentist license must comply with section 18341 and must provide: |
| 23 24 | A. Verification of a doctoral degree in dentistry from a dental school accredited as required by board rule; |
| 25 26 27 | B. Verification that the applicant has been licensed as a dentist in good standing under the laws of this State or has an active dental license in good standing issued under the laws of another state or a Canadian province; |
| 28 | C. Verification of passing all examinations required by board rule; and |
| 29 30 | D. Verification that the purpose of the license is to offer free dental care in conjunction with a charitable or social organization. |

| 32 33 34 | This bill reestablishes in law the provision authorizing a license at no cost for a dentist licensed in another state or a Canadian province for the purpose of providing charitable care. |
