Automobiles owned by veterans who are granted free registration of those vehicles by the Secretary of State under Title 29-A, section 523, subsection 1 or who provide certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States that they are permanently disabled and receive benefits based on a rating of 100% for service-connected disability;
9 10 11	SUMMARY This bill provides a motor vehicle excise tax exemption for veterans who are receiving benefits based on 100% permanent service-connected disability.
