COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 461, L.D. 1411, “An Act To Establish the Maine Buy American and Build Maine Act”

Amend the bill in section 5 in c. 168 in §2047 in subsection 4 in paragraph A in the first line (page 3, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$500" and inserting the following: '\$5,000 per item or per purchase order'

Amend the bill in section 5 in c. 168 in §2049 by striking out all of subsections 2 and 3 (page 5, lines 22 to 35 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

2. Public improvements. If, pursuant to section 1743-A, an in-state contractor submits a bid for a public improvement that is substantially similar to but substantially higher than other submitted bids, the public agency shall give the bid from the in-state contractor a preference of 10% applied in a manner determined by the department in rules adopted pursuant to section 2050. If more than one in-state contractor submits a bid that is substantially similar to but substantially higher than other submitted bids, the public agency shall give each in-state contractor a preference of 10% applied in a manner determined by the department in rules adopted pursuant to section 2050.

3. Procurements. If, pursuant to section 1825-B, an in-state contractor submits a bid that is substantially similar to but substantially higher than other submitted bids, the public agency shall give the bid from the in-state contractor a preference of 10% applied in a manner determined by the department in rules adopted pursuant to section 2050. If more than one in-state contractor submits a bid that is substantially similar to but substantially higher than other submitted bids, the public agency shall give each in-state contractor a preference of 10% applied in a manner determined by the department in rules adopted pursuant to section 2050.'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Sec. 6. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

31 **SUMMARY**

32 This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, raises the dollar value
 33 of a manufactured good to \$5,000 per item or per purchase order. It removes the
 34 opportunity for in-state contractors to submit a matching bid price and replaces it with a
 35 10% preference applied in a manner consistent with rules adopted by the Department of
 36 Administrative and Financial Services. The amendment also adds an appropriations and
 37 allocations section.
