An Act to Exempt Tractor Trailer Trucks from the Excise Tax

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1482, sub-§1, ¶C, as amended by PL 2013, c. 263, §1, is further amended by amending subparagraph (3) to read:
4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12	(3) For commercial vehicles manufactured in model year 1996 and after, the amount of excise tax due for trucks or truck tractors registered for more than 26,000 pounds and for Class A special mobile equipment, as defined in Title 29-A, section 101, subsection 70, the amount of excise tax due is based on the purchase price in the original year of title rather than on the list price. Verification of purchase price for the application of excise tax is determined by the initial bill of sale or the state sales tax document provided at point of purchase. The initial bill of sale is that issued by the dealer to the initial purchaser of a new vehicle the Class A special mobile equipment.
13	Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §1482, sub-§8 is enacted to read:
14 15	8. Exemptions. A truck or truck tractor registered for more than 26,000 pounds is exempt from the excise tax under this section.

17 18	This bill exempts trucks and truck tractors registered for more than 26,000 pounds from the excise tax.
