An Act to Require Online Used Car Dealers to Be Licensed

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §851, sub-§9-A is enacted to read:
- 9-A. Online used car dealer. "Online used car dealer" means a used car dealer that does not have an established place of business in the State, that has a primary place of business in another jurisdiction and that sells used motor vehicles through the use of a publicly accessible website or other Internet platform to a person located in the State.
 - **Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §901, sub-§3,** ¶**A,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
 - A. Whether the applicant intends to sell used motor vehicles and, if so, except for an online used car dealer, whether there is space for servicing and repairs;
 - **Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §901, sub-§3, ¶B,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
 - B. A Except for an online used car dealer, a certificate by a state police officer or a representative of the Secretary of State that the applicant has an established place of business at each business location in the State;
- **Sec. 4. 29-A MRSA §903, sub-§1, ¶C,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
 - C. For a dealer licensed under this chapter, except for an online used car dealer, failure to have an established place of business;
- **Sec. 5. 29-A MRSA §903, sub-§1, ¶D,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
 - D. Failure Except for an online used car dealer, failure to notify the Secretary of State in writing at least 30 days prior to moving the location of an established place of business;
 - **Sec. 6. 29-A MRSA §951, sub-§1, ¶B,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
 - B. Sells Except for an online used car dealer, sells more than 5 vehicles in any 12-month period; or
- **Sec. 7. 29-A MRSA §951, sub-§1, ¶B-1** is enacted to read:
- B-1. For an online used car dealer, sells more than 5 vehicles to one or more persons located in the State in any 12-month period; or
- **Sec. 8. 29-A MRSA §952, sub-§1,** as amended by PL 2021, c. 216, §§24 to 26, is further amended to read:
 - **1. Facilities.** To Except for an online used car dealer, to qualify for a dealer license, an applicant must maintain the following facilities and personnel:
 - A. Facilities for the display of vehicles being handled;
- B. A repair department for repair of vehicles;
- 38 C. Sufficient tools and equipment for servicing of the vehicles handled;

- D. A suitable office in which business is conducted and records of the business are kept; and
 - E. At least one mechanic, who may be the owner, who has a thorough knowledge of the vehicles being handled.
 - Sec. 9. 29-A MRSA §955, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

- 2-A. Online used car dealers obtaining a place of business in the State. An online used car dealer that obtains a place of business in the State is subject to the requirements of established places of business under this chapter and of facilities under section 952, subsection 1. This subsection does not apply to a facility owned by a 3rd party that inspects, services or repairs a motor vehicle pursuant to a contract with the online used car dealer.
- **Sec. 10. 29-A MRSA §957, sub-§1,** as enacted by PL 1997, c. 437, §26, is amended to read:
- 1. Annex license. The Except for an online used car dealer, the Secretary of State may issue to a dealer a license to operate an annex facility. An annex facility must be an established place of business, except that books and records may be kept at the dealer's primary location. An annex facility must meet the requirements of section 952, subsection 1. The annual fee for an annex license is \$150.
- **Sec. 11. 29-A MRSA §957, sub-§2,** as amended by PL 2013, c. 381, Pt. A, §3, is further amended to read:
- **2. Secondary location license.** The Except for an online used car dealer, the Secretary of State may issue to a dealer a license to operate at a secondary location. For the purposes of this subsection, "secondary location" means a display area that complies with applicable building codes and zoning and land use ordinances, is large enough to display at least 2 vehicles and contains signs posting the business's name and operating hours. The annual fee for a secondary location license is \$100.
- **Sec. 12. 29-A MRSA §1001, sub-§3,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
- 3. Display. A Except for an online used car dealer, a license must be conspicuously displayed at each location. An online used car dealer shall conspicuously display a license on the online used car dealer's publicly accessible website used for the sale of a motor vehicle to a person in the State.
- **Sec. 13. 29-A MRSA §1003, sub-§1,** as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
- 1. Application for certificate and plates. A dealer or an owner of a body shop, transmission shop or garage, except for an online used car dealer, may apply for a loaner license and plates.

37 SUMMARY

This bill requires online used car dealers to be licensed to sell motor vehicles to persons located in the State. The bill also sets out that an online used car dealer is a used car dealer that does not have an established place of business in the State, that has a primary place of business in another jurisdiction and that sells used motor vehicles through the use of a

website or other Internet platform to a person located in the State. If an online used car dealer obtains a place of business in the State, the online used car dealer is a used car dealer subject to requirements regarding established places of business in the State and facilities, except for a facility owned by a 3rd party that inspects, repairs or services motor vehicles pursuant to a contract with the online used car dealer. An online used car dealer is required to conspicuously post its license on the website used for sales of motor vehicles to persons in the State.
