SUMMARY

This amendment requires the Department of Health and Human Services to contract 18 for a 3rd-party independent rate study to develop a separate rate for MaineCare 19 reimbursement for trauma-focused cognitive behavioral therapy to be billed under rule 20 Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Section 65. Currently, this therapy is 21 available as outpatient therapy and home-based and community-based treatment under 22 23 Section 65. The rate study must take into consideration the costs to providers of 24 delivering the service, including certification and continuing education, quality assurance and continuous quality improvement, the need to attract enough providers to clear waiting 25 lists and serve all areas of the State and the costs to ensure fidelity to the therapy model. 26 27 The rate study must be completed no later than April 1, 2019, and the department must report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over health 28 and human services matters by May 1, 2019. The department must amend its rules to 29 30 establish the new rate. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations 31 section.
