1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 5	B. "Solicitation calls" means calls, including facsimile transmissions, the purpose of which is any of the following:
6	(1) To offer real property, goods or services for sale or rent;
7 8	(2) To convey information on real property, goods or services to solicit sales or purchases;
9	(3) To promote or solicit charitable contributions; or
10	(4) To gather data or statistics or solicit information.

13 14	E. Deliver information with the prior, written, express consent of the recipient of the call; Θ

22 23 24	This bill exempts gathering data or statistics from the prohibition on using an automated telephone calling device or an artificial or prerecorded voice to make solicitation calls.
