Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph E-1 in the last line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "plaintiff" the following: 'or prohibiting the defendant from being present at a specific location'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:
'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Provides one-time funding for costs associated with updating forms and the programming of 2 case management systems.


Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act takes effect January 1, 2025.'
Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

## SUMMARY

The bill amends the law governing protection from abuse orders to give the court the authority to issue a final protection order directing the defendant to refrain from knowingly being within a specified distance of the plaintiff. This amendment grants the court additional authority to prohibit the defendant from being present at a specific location
within a final protection from abuse order. It also provides that the legislation takes effect January 1, 2025.
