1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2304, sub-§1, ¶F** is enacted to read:

3 F. Seats on a school bus manufactured in 2025 or later must be made of flame-retardant
4 material.

6 This bill requires school buses manufactured in 2025 or later to have seats made of
7 flame-retardant material.
