Statement by Penny Morrell

LD 3 "An Act to Establish the Winter Energy Relief Payment Program to Aid Residents with High Heating Costs and to Finalize the COVID Pandemic Relief Payment Program"

Sen. Jackson, Rep. Talbot-Ross, and members of the Appropriations and Financial Affairs Committee, thank you for the opportunity to present before you. I am Penny Morrell, taxpayer and citizen of Belgrade, Maine.

This bill encapsulates a huge amount of money to spend. Accountability for funds spent is needed. The title leaves out an important part of the request for funds, which being homelessness.

The bill states that the president of the U.S. declared emergencies for the COVID-19 virus health crisis, increased energy prices, and "homelessness or housing instability". Hasn't the president's agenda caused these crises, as has our governor?

Dr. Fauci is being investigated for his connections to the Wuhan Lab where the COVID virus started in China.

When ANWAR opened, America was the leading supplier of fossil fuels. The president shut it down making us dependent on foreign oil.
