I think it is very important to make sure that there are spaces available where folks can get the help that they need.

Although I respect the fact that establishments need to be safe for people to live in, please do not make the rules so difficult to fulfill that these places are forced to shut down. Thank you for all of the work that you do, and please vote to oppose this bill.
