Senator Tipping, Representative Roeder, and distinguished members of the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs. My name is Dr. Holly Blair, and I am the Executive Director of the Maine Principals' Association – Professional Division. When the price of living continues to increase, it will go above the cap of \$24,186.25.
