My name is Lois Kilby-Chesley, and I am writing to you from my home in Durham, ME.

I am writing in support of LD 70 - An Act to Eliminate the Cap on Retirement Benefits for State Employees and Teachers to Which a Cost-of-living Adjustment Is Made.

This bill fixes an unfair change to state employee and teacher retirement that was made in 2011. The bill will allow a teacher's retirement to increase up to 3% without a monetary cap according to the CPI in any year.
