My name is Habone and I am here today to testify in favor of LD 199. I live in Lewiston, I am a mother of a 6 years old daughter. My husband died in a car accident three years ago while on duty for a transportation company.

I was new then when my husband died in that tragedy. I did not know or have means to support myself. I lost the Mainecare six months after the delivery of my child.

Since then I cannot afford going to the doctor or doing any annual medical check ups. For years I live without health care insurance and if I feel sick I buy my meds from the pharmacy. It's hard to be in the shoes of someone who feels left behind. I don't believe it's a matter of affordability for the state or the country but this is more about a choice for those who are deciding who should have access to healthcare.

I have a daughter who is an American citizen and every time I get sick, I have tremendous fear of passing on dangerous viruses or diseases. Going to the doctor is a huge challenge because of the cost of one visit or a prescription. For example I have a list of medications that I could not afford and a therapy session that was prescribed for me for muscle pain.

If I have access to healthcare, it will be a big moral uplifting and a boost for my mental and physical health. A healthy mother can raise a healthy child otherwise it's a heavy burden on my heart.

For that reason, I am calling you Honorables committee, to pass LD 199 for our families and public health investment.
