I support this bill because I believe younger people should have a much smoother transition than what I got. I also think it is important for individual needs to be assessed and for everyone to receive the services they need. We shouldn't have to be overwhelmed and stressed about it. I just want a smoother transition and for everyone to get what they need and be able to choose their services.

I agree that the youth should get priority as well as people who have been sitting on the wait list for years. I have been sitting on the wait list for section 21 since 2016. I am really upset and angry because my caseworker submitted an update on my situation about my health issues in December and I have had no response.

I need services now and I can't wait any longer for a waiver spot. My health issues are not going to get any better. I just can't wait a bunch of more years for services. I do fine now, but what will happen when my health issues get worse. I also can't get assistive technology and I need it. I feel like they are not looking at things, but it isn't helping people who have been on the wait list for years.

I am hopeful that the Lifespan Waiver will help solve some of these issues like I have experienced. I would ask you to support LD 659 and vote to pass it. Thank you for your time and consideration.
