Although all we have to go by is the title and brief summary, it is clear that this bill represents the persisting stigma against the cannabis industry. I noticed this bill does not include the smell of the paper mill in Mexico. It does not include the smell of yeast that radiates from Country Kitchen in Lewiston. It does not include the spraying of manure across countless farms in Maine. While I may not be particularly fond of any of these smells, I understand that some amenities in society have smells associated with them. That's the way it is, and the way it's always been.

I'll keep my testimony short today, because I know the legislature is busy with serious bills. Please kill LD 410.
