## Testimony in Support of LD 1286 "Resolve, to Establish the Blue Economy Task Force to Support Maine's Emergence as a Center for Blue Economy Innovation and Opportunity in the 21st Century"

Senator Curry, Representative Roberts, and distinguished members of the Committee on Innovation, Development, Economic Advancement and Business:

I write to you on behalf of the City of Portland's Legislative/Nominating Committee in Support of LD 1286, Resolve, to Establish the Blue Economy Task Force to Support Maine's Emergence as a Center for Blue Economy Innovation and Opportunity in the 21st Century.

Maine's marine industries are an iconic foundation of the State's economic system. Fishing, aquaculture, marine transportation, marine construction, boat building, and vessel repair are critical to both Portland and coastal Maine.
