Senator Baldacci, Representative Meyer, and Members of the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services:

This letter is to provide information on LD 1224, *Resolve, Directing the Department of Health and Human Services to Seek Federal Approval for Reimbursement of Community-based Mobile Crisis Intervention Services.* This resolve directs the Department to submit to the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) any waivers or state plan amendments determined necessary in order to reimburse community-based mobile crisis intervention services.

MaineCare is already well into the process of doing this work. The State Plan Amendment (SPA) hasn't been submitted yet, but the Department received a CMS planning grant and have been working with stakeholders over the last year to develop this service. The Department is already mid-way through the process to determine rates for the new community-based mobile crisis intervention services. The goal is for the service to be effective fall 2023 and the SPA to be submitted this fiscal year.
