Testimony for LD1215 An Act to End the Sale of Flavored Tobacco Products

Unfortunately, this led to the both of us having to watch Aidan go through nicotine withdrawals and be sick for weeks. Aidan has admitted that vaping actually causes her more anxiety and now she just feels as if she is in a trap she cannot get out of. Shortly after that she committed to a partner who was already addicted to vaping and has no plans on quitting.

To quote my father, I will say I watched the light get sucked out of my sister from being addicted to nicotine and it all started with a flavor.
