## MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: LD 1049, An Act to Protect Maine's Inland Fisheries from Invasive Fish

Committee Chair Senator LaFountain, Committee Chair Representative Landry and distinguished members of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife,

Thank you for allowing me to submit testimony for LD 1049, An Act to Protect Maine's Inland Fisheries from Invasive Fish.

Piscataquis County is known for its sportsmen's activities, and one of the most important among them is the fishing. The economic draw is vital to our communities, and as LD 1049 specifically addresses Sebec Lake and Schoodic Lake and the dams in Milo, Lakeview Plantation and Dover Foxcroft, all of which are in my constituent district, this bill is extremely important to the protection of the ecological and economic resources of Piscataquis County.

In order to protect this important part of our economy and to protect the delicate ecological balances established within our inland waterways, reasonable measures must be taken to arrest the spread of invasive species. The most important example of this is the Northern Pike, but could also include Catfish and other species. If this bill is not passed, the danger to the native cold water game fish in my region is not only possible, but almost guaranteed over time. This would be especially disastrous for Sebec Lake, which is one of the four original land locked Salmon lakes in the state, but would also destroy the Trout in the upper Piscataquis rivershed. Additionally, any expansion of of invasive species up the Piscataquis River and into surrounding lakes bring them dangerously close to Moosehead Lake.
