Good morning, Senator Rafferty, Representative Brennan and members of the Education & Cultural Affairs Committee. My name is Janice Vance and I am a resident of Kennebunk – one of Senator Rafferty's constituents. I am also a member of the Maine Gun Safety Coalition. I cannot be present to testify today. Please don't bother advancing this bill.
