The percentage that Maine contributes to SSI not being updated since 1974 is ridiculous and really needs to be changed. Especially with the way the economy is currently.

People not being able to live the way they want is obviously going to affect their mental health. I am also part of the Consumer Council System of Maine and mental health concerns are very important to me. I don't think the marriage penalty is right. It is an antiquated system and it is not giving people the opportunity to live life like they want to.

It is limiting our abilities as persons with disabilities, which are already limited in certain ways. We don't need to be limited more.
