## Testimony of Ruby Goodmen In support of LD 1726: An Act to Build Maine's Economy by Supporting Child Care for Working Families sponsored by Senate President Troy Jackson

I support shortened time periods for determining subsidy eligibility because too long of wait time can cause financial hardship or loss of job.

I support shortened time periods for child care programs receiving subsidy reimbursement because longer time without payment means a stressed daycare trying to make payroll and buy food for kids.
